SITE INFORMATION

- As always, everyone must pick up after their dogs and have them on leash while on the show premises.
- No practicing in the rings is allowed at anytime. You may declare your run as For Exhibition Only (FEO). For FEO, you may use a toy in the ring, but you may not throw the toy.
- No food or treats allowed in the ring
- ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN CRATED, IN THE RING, OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.

TRIAL REGULATIONS - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: In the AKC ACT program, owners/agents may register their dogs for any jump height. All height divisions will be offered in both ACT1 and ACT2.

OBSTACLES: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 for the first entry of a dog, \$15.00 for subsequent entries of the same dog. Fees include AKC recording fee of \$5.00 per dog per entry.

CLOSING DATE: Monday, September 1, 2025, at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

CANCELLATIONS: In order for cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received. No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: All refund requests received prior to the close of entries will be charged a \$3.00 per day processing fee. After the close of entries, only refund requests for bitches in season can be accepted. No veterinarian letter is required.

MIXED BREEDS: All mixed breed dogs are welcome to participate in the AKC ACT program. Under "Breed" on the entry form, dogs must be listed as "All American" and not as a breed hybrid. If you would like to register your dog with AKC, we will be able to assist you with on-line registration at the event. Mixed breed dogs are required to be neutered/spayed to be registered.

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Show Site Rules

- 3. Dispose of your own dog's waste in the pail behind the building.
- 4. Owners and Handler are responsible for cleaning up for their dogs and Canine New England may charge a \$20 cleaning fee for dogs who foul the ring.
- 5. Do not litter.
- 6. No Flexi-Leads, E-Collars, or Prong collars permitted on show grounds.
- 7. No smoking is permitted in or around the building.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

E-MAIL CONFIRMATIONS will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
