Trial setup will be Friday November 14 at noon. Anyone who comes to help is welcome to setup their crating area AFTER trial setup is complete.

Medina Swarm now has a water station. Please bring a refillable water bottle. Bottled water will not be provided.

This also includes if there was a correction to a scribe sheet – the handler must verify that the results were corrected as well.
