

## **Welcome to the Canine New England Mock Agility Trial!**

Please **DO NOT** call the front desk as they are not hosting this trial and will not have information about it. Best of luck for a clean run!

### **Confirmation Information**

- You should have received an email for your entry confirmation when you registered. If you did not, please check your spam folder or contact me ASAP so that I can resend it. Your information is also located at the bottom of this email, please check to make sure it is correct.

### **Start Time**

- Building opens to competitors at 8:00AM.
- There will be a judges briefing at 8:45AM.
- First walk through will begin promptly after the briefing.
- First dog on the line at 9:00AM.

### **Jump Height**

- Please make sure that the height you chose on your entry form is correct on your entry confirmation email.

### **Maps**

- Maps will be available on My Dog Entry the morning of the trial at 7:00am.
- There will be no paper copies for maps at this trial.
- Maps will be posted at the trial site. I suggest that you take pictures of your maps with your phone or tablet when you arrive.

### **Crating and Set Up**

- There is indoor crating available. This crating will be to the left of the agility field, the training space with the red barriers. There will be no crating on front of the agility field, however you may place chairs there for viewing.
- Please place a mat or tarp under your crate.
- We will be sharing this space with those participating in a dock diving event, so please be considerate when setting up.
- The venue will open its doors at 8:00AM for exhibitors to set up. No one will be allowed into the building prior to this.

## Site Information

- Canine New England will also have their rehabilitation center open on this day. We ask that you leave the parking spaces open that are marked for this purpose. Anyone who parks in these spaces will be asked to move.
- The second and third door will be used for the agility field. Please do not use the first door as that is the rehab center .
- All exhibitors must pick up after their dogs. There is a potty area at the front of the building with poop bags and trash cans. Please use this area and do not allow your dogs to potty on the neighbors lawns.

## Volunteers

- Please sign up at the trial to help out. This helps the day go by much quicker and efficiently.
- Brand new to trialing? Don't worry, we will show you how to do the different jobs! Each job is important, even if it's just setting bars! :)

## Running Order

- We will be running the events in the following order:
  - Standard
  - Standard #2
  - Gamblers
  - Jumpers
  - Jumpers #2
- We will be running from small to tall in height.
- Complete run order is posted on [mydogentry.com](http://mydogentry.com).

## **Checking In**

- We will have a table set up for check in.
- It is important that you check when you arrive, as these sheets are used for the running order in the events.
- If leaving early, please write ABS on the gate sheet so we are not looking for you.

## **FEO / NFC**

- We will be offering NFC / FEO for all runs.
- You will have the Standard Course Time for each course to train as you please.
- You can use toys as long as they do not squeak.
- We will have a food reward station at the front of the ring where you can reward your dog. This will be the only area food can be used! You must reward from your hand, no tossing treats on the floor. Please do not use crumbly treats!
- You must state that you are running FEO / NFC when you enter the ring.

## **Payment**

- If you have not yet made payment, please find me when you arrive. I will most likely be in the field or at the desk on the computer.
- You must make payment before your first run.
- Please bring a check or cash, credit cards will not be accepted the day of.
