Running Order will be as follows (all searches will run concurrently):

- Saturday = Jen; Sunday = Jeremy (Containers Round 1 & Round 2)
- Saturday = Jeremy; Sunday = Jen (Interiors Round 1 & Exteriors Round 1)
- Saturday = Susan; Sunday = Lisa (Interiors Round 2 & Exteriors Round 2)
- Saturday = Lisa; Sunday = Susan (Containers Round 3 & Vehicles Round 1)

Recommended arrival at the farm for **SATURDAY**:

- Level 1 & 2 competitors no later than 7:30 AM
- Level 3 competitors no later than 12 PM
- Level 5 competitors no later than 9 AM
- Level C competitors no later than 9 AM

Recommended arrival at the farm for **SUNDAY**:

- Level 1 & 2 competitors no later than 7:30 AM
- Level 3 competitors no later than 12 PM
- Level 5 competitors no later than 9 AM
- Level C competitors no later than 9 AM

NOTE THE TIMES PROVIDED ABOVE ARE RECOMMENDATIONS, and containers will likely run quickly. Therefore, plan to arrive no later than the times provided above. If we notice Saturday runs quicker than planned, we will send an email notifying of any changes.

GENERAL BRIEFING: The general briefing will be conducted in the competitor parking lot.

JUDGE'S CLASS BRIEFINGS: The judges will provide an overview of your searches around 7:45am. This briefing will include total time allowed per search and number of hides if known. Please read the rule book before the trial to familiarize yourself with the requirements for your level to qualify.

ENTERING AND EXITING THE SEARCH AREAS: Signs will be provided to show the locations to enter each search area. Volunteers will provide assistance should you have any questions.

Onsite Food: We WILL have breakfast AND lunch BOTH DAYS provided by Tacos el Terrible!

PARKING: Enter the fairgrounds from **English Prairie Road – follow the tree line to the parking lot.**

CRATING: No indoor crating will be available. All crating will be out of your car. Please plan accordingly (fans, sunshades, etc.)!

WALK-THRUS: Walk-thrus will be up to the discretion of the judges.

CHECK-IN & RUNNING ORDERS: We will have running orders posted at the front entrance for each search area. There will be Gate Stewards to help you. If you have a conflict, please let them know so they can adjust accordingly.

PRACTICE BOXES: Will be made available before your search. One set of boxes will be located near the competitor parking lot.

RESTROOMS: We will have indoor restrooms nearest to the competitor parking lot inside the main building of the farm. We will discuss and show you during the morning briefing. Ask a volunteer if you need assistance finding them.

RESULTS: Results are planned to be posted on a table near the restrooms in the main building. Remember to be respectful of others and their space, and **do NOT bring dogs into this building.**

RIBBONS: There will be no “self-serve” ribbons. We will have an area set up for you to pick up your ribbon and/or label. If you earn an element title, please let us know and we will provide you the appropriate ribbon (and congratulations in advance!).
