

Tournament Information

Fusion Tournament – Friday July 3, 2026

This Tournament will combine scores from two classes: Tournament Standard and Tournament Jumpers

- Each of these classes will be one course for all levels.
- Tournament scoring will be the dog's time plus course faults with the winner being those with the lowest scores.
 - (i.e. Dog's Time = 30.26 and has 15 faults – total score is 45.26, If another dog has a time of 41.04 but no faults, they would be the winner as their time plus faults is less than the other dog).
- The two classes will be combined for the Overall Fusion Tournament 1st through 3rd place Winners.
- A Podium presentation will be done at the end of the day.
- Individual class winners will be provided trophies from the host clubs.
- The Overall combined Fusion Tournament winners will be provided an award provided by CPE.
- Tournament placing will be done in the following groupings Reg/Vet Small (4,8,12 Regular), Reg/Vet Large (16V (jumping 12), 16, 20, 24) and Enth/Spec Small (4,8,12) and Enth/Spec Large (16,20).

Standard and Jumpers qualifiers can also be earned in these classes using your normal CPE scoring rules for your level. Regular placement ribbon and qualifying flat ribbons provided by the clubs.

Screwball Tournament – Saturday July 4, 2025:

This Tournament will combine scores from two classes: Tournament Standard and Tournament Snookpot.

- Each of these classes will be one course for all levels.
- Tournament scoring for STANDARD will be the dog's time plus course faults with the winner being those with the lowest scores. (same as Fusion scoring mentioned previously).

- The Snookpot class is a blend of Snooker and Traditional Jackpot. The teams will perform a Snooker course per usual that will lead directly into a Traditional Jackpot distance challenge.
- When you have accumulated enough Snooker points for your level, you may take the Snooker Finish jump and move on to the Jackpot part of the course. The course time for Big Dogs (24/20/16/16v) will be 70 seconds and the total game time for Small Dogs (12/8/4) will be 75 seconds.

IMPORTANT: General Briefing and Scoring Rules of Snookpot:

- If you are “whistled” off on the snooker course, you are **NOT** eligible to move on to the Jackpot. You will score 0 (zero) for both parts of the course.
- If you successfully complete snooker and do not choose to attempt the Jackpot part of the course, you will earn the points for Snooker and be able to get a Snooker Qualifying leg but will get 0 (zero points) for the gamble.
- If you choose to attempt the Jackpot part of the course and are not successful (including being over total game time), you will get a Zero on both the Snooker and Jackpot courses and overall, 0 (zero) tournament points for Snookpot. Remember NO HORN is heard unless you are 6 seconds over time, so you may be overtime and not know it till your sheet is scored.
- If you are not successful with the overall total points to qualify at your level in Snooker and you attempt the Jackpot because you thought you had enough points, and you successfully complete the Jackpot, you will get 0 (Zero) points in both Snooker and Jackpot as you did not successfully complete the Snooker.
- If you are successful in Snooker and you successfully complete the Jackpot under the total game time, you will earn your Snooker points and you will get 44 points for the Jackpot section earning a qualifying score in both Snooker and Jackpot and will earn the combined points toward the overall Screwball tournament.
- This class will be scored by taking 100 minus your game point with the winner being those with the lowest score (with time being only used to break a points tie breaker).

SNOOKPOT QUESTIONS: If you have questions, please email me and ask and I will try to address them as we will not have time to repeat all of this at the show and I would rather clarify all questions upfront. Course

specific questions, the judge we will brief at the show but questions on if you can do the gamble, not do the gamble, scoring etc, I would like to answer upfront if the above is not clear to all.

- The two classes will be combined for the Overall Screwball Tournament 1st through 3rd place Winners.
- A Podium presentation will be done at the end of the day.
- Individual class winners will be provided trophies from the host clubs.
- The Overall combined Screwball Tournament winners will be provided an award provided by CPE.
- Tournament placing will be done in the following groupings Reg/Vet Small (4,8,12 Regular), Reg/Vet Large (16V (jumping 12), 16, 20, 24) and Enth/Spec Small (4,8,12) and Enth/Spec Large (16,20).

Standard, Snooker, and Jackpot qualifiers can also be earned in these classes using your normal CPE scoring rules for your level. Regular placement ribbon and qualifying flat ribbons provided by the clubs.

Overall Festival Tournament Champion:

The overall Festival Champions will take a combined score of Fusion (Standard/Jumpers) and Screwball (Standard/Snookpot) classes over the two days and determine the overall Festival Champions.

- 1st – 3rd place. A Podium presentation will be done at the end of the day Saturday.
- Placing will be done in the following groupings Reg/Vet Small (4,8,12 Regular), Reg/Vet Large (16V (jumping 12), 16, 20, 24) and Enth/Spec Small (4,8,12) and Enth/Spec Large (16,20).

Team:

This tournament will consist of two dogs whose scores from all regular classes offered on Friday (FullHouse, Snooker, Standard, Wildcard) and Saturday (Jackpot, Jumpers, Standard, Colors) will be combined to determine overall Team Winners.

- Team can be mixed height and consist of two separate handlers and dogs in Regular/Veteran or two in Enthusiast/Specialist.
- Standard, Colors, Wildcard, Jumpers will be Scored Time plus faults.
- Snooker, Jackpot and FullHouse will be scored 100 – game points (time will only be considered if a tiebreaker exists).
- The winners will have the lowest overall combined scores.
- The overall team winners Regular/Veteran and Enthusiast/Specialist Large and Small placed 1st to 4th will be provided an award provided by CPE.

Class qualifiers can also be earned in these classes using your normal CPE scoring rules for your level. You can enter these classes and not enter team for regular qualifiers.

Sunday

All classes offered on Sunday are regular classes, no tournaments offered on Sunday.

- We will still be running in groups so that both rings run at the same time. See respective run order.
