Location

The trial is being held at Paws Pack Dog Training & Sports at:

160 Pigeon Road, Wagener, South Carolina 29164

We are the only residence/business on Pigeon Road so when you drive down the road you will come to a large field with a white fenced agility ring and dock diving pool.

UKI Trial Start Times

Friday

- 3:00 pm - Trial Opens
- 3:45 pm - Measuring will start
- 4:00 pm - General Briefing, followed by first walkthrough
- 4:15pm - Judging Starts

Saturday and Sunday will follow the same schedule:

- 8:00 am - Trial Opens
- 8:15 am - Measuring will start
- 8:45 am - General Briefing, followed by first walkthrough
- 9:00 am - Judging Starts

Note on Measuring: Dogs that need to be measured must be done before they run, and it is the competitors' responsibility to know if they need to be measured. Measuring will occur behind the ring near the white tents and large black ring gate.

Please ensure you understand the new criteria regarding dogs being measured. UKI Rule Book edition 10. If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent. If you ask for a challenge measure when you have a permanent measure, you must state this when you are getting the dog measured so the correct protocol can be followed and you may not continue to challenge a measure when you have challenged it once.

Volunteers: We cannot do this without your help! We expect each class to move very quickly, so please jump in to help as much as possible. We have a volunteer raffle for the weekend.

Ribbons: We have some beautiful ribbons for Q's available. Please add your info to the ribbon signup sheet and we'll get a ribbon made up for you!

NQ Raffle: Our popular NQ raffle is back! If your run doesn't earn you a ribbon, then it earns you a ticket into the NQ raffle. There is a new prize to be won every day!

Parking: Car parking is located in the front field between the road and the ring. Please do not park next to the fenced ring. RVs should park by the woods on the far side of the pool. RV Dry Camping is offered at a fee of \$15 per night. If you haven't signed up already, please contact pawspackdogs@gmail.com to reserve your spot.

Crating: You can crate your dog in your car or in the front field as long as it is not up against the ring area.

Weather: The weather is predicted to be widely variable, with potential lows in the 40s to highs in the upper 70s, so wear lots of layers!

Dock Diving Pool: The Dock Diving Pool will be open to participants for cool-down swims ONLY (no dock diving practice during the trial). This is only for competitors to swim (it is not open to the general public). As always, please be considerate of dogs competing in the ring during your dog's swim cool downs. Please keep your dog on a leash to pool and leaving pool. Handlers must follow all verbal and posted safety instructions.

Cost for the weekend is \$25 per handler, payable cash or check at the trial. We will give out bracelets to identify those with a completed liability waiver and paid fee. Contact Patricia with questions at pawspackdogs@gmail.com.

Potty Time:

Humans - There will be port-a-potty(s) on site (located to the right of the agility ring set back in the wooded area)

Dogs - Dogs can access any of the surrounding area, but we ask that you please pick up after your dog. We will have short blue pails on each corner of the ring to drop all bags into. Please put all food and other garbage in the black trash cans located at the top two corners of the ring.

Mulligans / Fun Runs: Mulligan runs will be offered after the conclusion of the trial each day at \$5.00 per run
