Set-up, Start Time, Crating, Refreshments, Course Maps and Doggie Doo

Companion Dog Club will open for set up at 11:00 AM Saturday, February 21st. The address is 10802 N 72nd Street, Omaha, Nebraska. Please arrive and set-up to allow for course walking at 11:45 AM. **The first dog is on the line at 12:00 PM.** Only the handlers/dog holders, dog(s) on the line and course marshals are allowed to enter the ring during the rounds. Dogs must be crated while you walk the course.

Soft drinks are available for volunteers. Please bring dog water.


Use the grassy area south of the entrance door to potty your dog. Please pick up after your dog. Bring poo bags to dispose of waste.

Course maps will be emailed to you by Saturday AM. They are also available on the mydogentry.com website. There will be a copies posted at the site. The course numbers and bonus lines change for each round.

Ribbons and BRAG TAGS

You can earn and choose either 1st, 2nd or 3rd place ribbons or 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th place Brag Tags, a Qualifying ribbon or Brag Tag and a ribbon or Brag Tag for your new title. Check your points earned on the CPE members only site. Speedway titles are earned by points awarded and the total for all events. If you earned your title at one of our previous Companion Dog Club Speedway Trials, please take your Brag Tag.

Brag Tags

Brag Tags can be added to your ribbon display, put on a necklace or bracelet, added to a keychain, put on a dog collar or dog crate. There will be ball chains or key loops available for you to put your Brag Tags on to start your display. Please take one chain/loop per dog.

General Rules – Course Marshal Briefing

- Slingshot is a numbered course consisting of hoops and tunnels. There are two bonus lines. One for 3x and one for 1.5x bonus points. Maximum Course Time (MCT) is 60 seconds. To earn the bonus points the run must be clean.
- Dog may run naked or with a flat-buckle collar, with NO attachments and nothing dangling. See the CPE rulebook for more information.
- Handler may either toss leash aside at the start-line, or carry the leash as belt, lanyard or in pocket. If the dog grabs the leash during the run, the leash is then considered a toy and the run is Training in the Ring.
- You cannot touch your dog or any obstacles during your run.
- If dog takes an off-course obstacle (skips an obstacle, enters the incorrect end of the tunnel) just fix it and continue to finish the course from there. The handler may even go back to previous obstacles to get back on track. The only penalty is time spent. The handler may fix mistakes multiple times.
- Declared Training in the Ring (DTIR) is allowed – the toy does not have to be pre-approved by a course marshal.
- The toy must be silent, this includes crinkle toys, must remain in the handler's hand and must not have been designed to hold food.
- No food allowed in the ring.
- If the handler leaves the dog in a start line stay, passes the plane of the first obstacle and walks back to reposition the dog, handler must then run with the dog (cannot lead out again). **NQ (Training in the Ring) if handler leads out again.**
- At 60 seconds a horn/buzzer will sound or the Course Marshall will whistle that your ring time is ended. Please exit promptly.

The following will result in a Non-Qualifying Run (NQ):

- Dog eliminates in the ring.
- Dog goes off-course and the off-course is never fixed.
- Dog leaves the course or is out of control.
- Dog does not complete the course within Max Course Time (MCT).
- Declared Training in the Ring (DTIR) runs are not Qualifying runs.
