

Welcome to MudPACK's April 2026 CPE trial. We are looking forward to seeing you at MudPACK's "Splish Splashin' Away" CPE Agility trial!

Please read the following exhibitor information letter carefully and let us know if you have any questions.

The 2026 CPE Agility (AG) rules are in effect – please review either your rulebook or the CPE website at www.cpe.dog

We are thrilled to be using the Boand Arena again. Boand Arena is privately leased by Silver Spurs from Kitsap County Fairgrounds. We have restroom facilities as well as porta potties. Please let us know if you have any questions or concerns.

Confirmations

This letter accompanies your final confirmation. Contact me immediately if there are corrections necessary for your final confirmation.

If you might finish a C-ATCH, C-ATE, CS-ATCH, or CT-ATCH during the trial and have not let me know yet, please email me as soon as possible before the trial. Let us know so we can celebrate with you!

Parking

There are plenty of parking spaces for vehicles. Please obey all signs.

Camping

Dry camping is free. Electrical connections are available for \$15 per night and can be paid at the Trial Secretary Desk when you arrive and then you will be given a Parking Sign to post on your RV. These power locations are along the white fencing next to the Fairgrounds Event Center parking area on the Boand Arena side, and parking is on the grassy field side of the white fencing. Bring extra long power extension cords to power outlets. The electrical RV sites are over 75 yards from the Arena.

Please note: the main access gate off Nel Nelson Road will be shut but not locked at night. If you decide to leave the site after MudPACK members have left, please close but do not lock the access gate after you exit and then after you re-enter.

Set Up

We will be setting up Rings and some equipment on Friday morning around 10am. Any volunteers to help with the setup is greatly appreciated. You may begin setting up your crating area Friday morning after the ring setups are finished.

Additional Housekeeping Information

We will have bathrooms with showers available on the back side of the Boand Arena. Porta potties will also be located near the arena. There are plenty of restaurants, grocery stores, hotels, etc., near Silverdale.

MESSAGE FROM THE TRIAL SECRETARY

We will be using hard copy run order sheets for each class. Please be ready to enter the ring when it's your turn.

COURSE MAPS – The course maps for the next day will be available through My Dog Entry and will not be emailed out as they will be posted on the My Dog Entry website.

Measuring and Check-In:

All dogs without a permanent card must be measured before their first run. A reminder will be sent on Tuesday, April 21st to those needing measurement. Measuring times each day: Fri: 11:00 am, Sat & Sun: 7:15-7:30 am. NOTE: Height cards with an actual measurement, from another Agility Venue (AKC and USDAA), may now be used in lieu of a measurement at a CPE trial.

Be sure to get measured and check with the Trial Secretary if you need to change the height or category of your dog before your first run.

There is no formal check-in for this trial.

Walk-through and Starting Times:

The trial will start each day with the first dog on the line ready to run at 12:00pm on Friday, 8 am on Saturday and Sunday. The first course of the day will open for walk-through at approximately 11:30 am on Friday and 7:30 am Saturday and Sunday. There will be a general briefing in the morning each day.

Crating: We allow crating in the Arena area – along the fencing parallel to the rings. Setup is allowed after the Arena is setup and ready to go on Friday morning.

Volunteer: We will be using a White Board to sign up to volunteer. Volunteers can help the trial run smoother. Coupons will be given to volunteers and can be used for the Raffle.

Raffle: We will have worker raffles on Saturday and Sunday. Tickets earned on Friday may be used on Saturday or Sunday.

Food: There will be no Hospitality food at this trial – please plan accordingly. Water will be available.

Move-Ups

Move-ups from Friday to Saturday/Sunday and Saturday to Sunday will be accepted at the trial. There will be a move-up sheet available each day. All move-up requests for Saturday must be submitted by ½ hour after the Scores have been posted on Friday. All move-up requests for Sunday must be submitted by ½ hour after the Scores have been posted on Saturday. Move-ups Saturday or Sunday mornings for that day cannot be accepted.

Day Of Show Entries will be allowed (add \$4 per run) until our run limit is reached.

Day of Show Entries will only be accepted from 11:15-11:30am on Friday; 7:30-7:45 am Saturday and Sunday until our run limit is reached.

SCORES, RESULTS AND RIBBONS

Ribbons will be available and Stickers will be in a pouch with your name on it.

High In Trial:

We will award High In Trial for each level (1, 2, 3, 5, & C). It will be awarded after completion of the **11th run (Sunday's Standard)**.

Don't forget to put your name in for all your non-Q runs! There will be a drawing on Saturday and Sunday at the end of the last runs.
