

Letter to Speedway (SW) Exhibitors: MudPack SW CPE Trial April 24-26, 2026

We look forward to the MudPack CPE Speedway trial April 24-26, 2026 at Board Equestrian Arena Silver Spurs Club, Bremerton, WA. Please take a moment to read the following information.

Speedway will be running in ring 1 while Agility is in ring 2.

SET UP: The Speedway trial committee will be setting up the courses each morning. We welcome anyone who is willing to come and help with set up. Exhibitors must either crate from their car or there will be crating space inside the arena along the aisle.

CHECK-IN and DAY OF SHOW: There will be Speedway information near Entry/Exit to Ring 1. Day of Show entries will be taken at \$14 per run at the secretary table.

SPEEDWAY COURSE MAPS: Will be posted near the Course Marshal Check-in table (in the middle of Ring 1 and available in [MyDog Entry](#) at 7am each morning. Walkthroughs will be available as soon as the courses have been set up. You can walk anytime when people are not running.

RUN ORDER: *Agility runs always take priority.*

FRIDAY: Pitstop Rd 1 & 2 (available to run between 12:30-2pm or until all exhibitors have completed their runs) then we will renumber and run Pitstop Rd 3 & 4. This is a double run format where it is run twice (same course) then changed and run twice on the new course numbering.

SATURDAY: Slingshot Rd 1 & 2 (available to run between 8:30-11am or until all exhibitors have completed their runs) then we will renumber and run Slingshot Rd 3 & 4. This is a double run format where it is run twice (same course) then changed and run twice on the new course numbering.

SUNDAY: Hairpin Teams Rd 1 & 2 (available to run starting at 8:30am until all exhibitors have completed their runs) then we will renumber and run Hairpin Teams Rd 3 & 4. Once those rounds are complete we will renumber and run Rd 5 & 6. This is a triple run format where it is run twice (same course) then changed, run twice on the new course numbering and then changed one more time and run twice on the final course numbering. You can run with the same or different partner. You can choose any partner who is entered and we can help pair you up.

When you are ready to run, come to the course marshal table, and find your scribe sheet (alphabetical by dog name) and hand it to the course marshal. Wait your turn then run with your dog.

RESULTS and AWARDS: Speedway results and awards will be in a binder at the same place as the agility awards and scores. Scores will be out as soon as possible once everyone has run in each of the rounds.

For those of you who don't take qualifying or placement ribbons or tags, you may put a note in the ribbon donation jar for the ribbons you did not take. Rather than putting in a ticket for each ribbon you don't take, we recommend that you wait until the end of the day or the end of the trial and just put a total of ribbons not taken, along with your name, into the container that will be at the Awards table. MudPACK will make a donation to Old Dog Haven for each ribbon not taken.

HOSPITALITY: There will be no worker hospitality at this trial. Everyone is urged to plan ahead and bring their own food and beverages and bring plenty of water for you and your dogs.

ABOUT THE SITE: We will have bathrooms available on the back side of the Board Arena. Porta potties will also be located near the arena with handwash station. Hand Sanitizer will also be available.

There is plenty of parking for vehicles. RVs who desire to have electrical hook-ups will park along the fencing to the north of the Board Arena. Do not block RV's. Please obey all signs, including not parking around the RV's unless you have had a conversation with the RV owner.. If you have requested camping, please see Leslie Cole the agility secretary to get your camping window sign so we know you have arrived. Please place the sign in a visible spot that can be seen outside your RV or camper.

DOG ETIQUETTE: Our goal is to keep everyone and every dog safe and have fun. We are going to try to keep the number of dogs limited to inside the building as a precaution against confrontations with other dogs – so basically don't just hang out with your dog in the building unless you are running soon or just ran. Dogs come into the ring on leash and leave the ring on leash, even if you are carrying them. Stay connected with your dog and always know where your dog's head is and what he/she is looking at. Do not let your dog interact with other dogs and do not approach another handler's dog without the permission of that dog's handler. This is for your safety as well as your dog's. Dogs must be on leash at all times except at the warmup equipment area and in the few paddocks that are specifically posted as off leash areas. Dogs should only potty in appropriate areas and you **MUST PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG**. No matter where the poo or the size of the poo, you must pick it up and dispose of it in the waste receptacles.

COLLARS: Dogs are allowed to run with flat buckle collars on. No tags or other decorative collar attachments are allowed.
