Confirmation Information: Please verify all information on the Final Confirmation. If there are any discrepancies, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Day of Show Entries: We will be accepting Day of Show Entries up until 8:00 AM at \$15 per run. Payment by exact cash or check. You must have a CPE ID# in order to play.

Check-In: Check-in will be from 7:45 to 8:15 AM. The site will open at 7:30 AM. **First dog on the line at 8:30** barring no software issues.

Measuring: There is no measurement needed at this time for Speedway. A measurement from any venue can be used with proper paperwork but is not required with Speedway. We will have a jump bar near the secretary table to give you an estimated jump height to run but you do not need a P card.

Judging & Running Order: This is a one ring trial. Each class grouping will have a single walk-thru with everyone entered walking together, the walk through will be 5 minutes long. There will be a briefing before the class by the Lead Course Marshal for that class. Please listen carefully and feel free to ask questions. Please potty your dog after your walk through and brief. You can run your dog back-to-back if you choose as our Pitstop and Slingshot Courses do not change from round 1 to round 3, nor do the Single Pole Position or Hairpin team courses. We are totally open to back-to-back runs or running your dog in round 1, round 2 and round 3 just let us know. We are flexible! We will be using **MYDOENTRY** for gate run order (if all software functions as we hope) Please open the attached cheatsheet for MYDOENTRY to open it on your phone browser or save it to your home screen on your phone as we hope this will streamline gate check in and run order. The course maps should also load into MYDOENTRY.

There is no judge in Speedway. We have volunteer Course Marshals. The Course Marshals attending this event will be Steve Quinn, Carolann Mullins, Lora Cooper, and Lauren Goldworthy representing The Dog Training Club of Tampa, other CPE course Marshals may be on site also. Steve Quinn is our lead Course Marshall for this trial. Carolann Mullins is our Trial Chair for this trial.

If you have entered a team event without a designated partner, you will be paired with another dog.

Exhibitor Information & Setup: Setup is available on Friday, June 12th from 12 to 2 PM. We can always use extra hands on Friday Set up so please join us if your available.

Our dog potty place is at the end of the parking lot. Please pick up after your dog. Please be sure your dog is on a leash except when in the ring. **Dogs in the ring must have a flat collar with nothing attached or they may run naked.**

Parking: There is plenty of parking. We do share our parking lot with other businesses, please do not plug EV's into any electrical receptacles when parking.

Volunteers: We do need volunteers to help build the courses. If you have had experience, we would appreciate the help. If you'd like to learn, again please help! We have raffle tickets for volunteers and pull small item worker raffles at the end of each day!

We typically finish by 2:30 pm daily.

Dog and Handler Safety: *Always be aware of where your dog is in relation to any other dog and handler team when outside the ring. No nose to nose contact please, safety is a priority for all attending. When entering and exiting, remember do not enter the ring until the previous dog is on leash exiting the ring.*
