General Trial Site Rules

- Pick up after your dog and dispose of bagged poop in the trash cans.
- You may walk your dogs in the pasture that has a open gate.
- DO NOT OPEN ANY GATE THAT IS CLOSED.
- Please plan to crate your dogs in your car which is next to the arena. You may also set up a tent and crate in the pasture. Please DO NOT crate your dog inside.
- Warm up jumps. We will have two set up.
- Chairs: I do have some plastic chairs, but you are welcome to set your chair up inside the arena. Space is limited.

Salem Veterinary Emergency Clinic: 3215 Market St NE, Salem OR 97301

COURSE MAPS: Will be emailed to you in the morning, put up on the website, posted onsite and available via [Trials - MyDogEntry](#) at 8: 00 AM.

Gate: We will be using My Dog Entries. It is web based and there will be a learning curve so be patient. You will be able to check in and see the progress of the show.

Volunteering: We rely on the generosity of competitors to work at the trials. Working jobs include Gate (using My Dog Entry), Scribe, Timers, Bar Setters and Leash Runners, as well as help with course building. Sign up on the whiteboard at the trial.

Raffle: We will have a self-service raffle for volunteers with prizes each day as well as a weekend draw for a free trial entry.

Snacks: We will provide light snacks, coffee and water for volunteers. The information/direction page above has a local restaurant page if you want to go out. I do have a microwave and fridge if you want to bring something.

Measuring: It is up to you to make sure your dog is measured BEFORE your run. You can check your UKI account to see if your dog needs measuring. (If there is * by their jump height, that means your dog has a permanent height card and does not need to be measured.) Your dog may wear a muzzle during measuring.

“If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog’s height must be done by the dog’s 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog’s first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent. If you ask for a challenge measure when you have a permanent measure, you must state this when you are getting the dog measured so the correct protocol can be followed and you may not continue to challenge a measure when you have challenged it once.” – UKI Administration

Payments: If you have not already paid, please pay before you run (Including Day of Show Entries).

Day of Show Entries: Up to start of walk through, you may enter the run (Cost is \$17 per run). There will be a QR Code available at the score table to access the form. Please pay before you run.

Moveups: We will be taking move-ups for Sunday’s runs. Please come to the score table to find the QR code for the moveup form.

Running multiple dogs: This is small trial, and we want everyone to have the ability to run your dogs even if you have multiple dogs.

- YOU must run your dogs in catalog order (meaning, the dog that is listed first must go first). You may move that dog to the top and the other dog to the bottom to have 9 other dogs between your runs.
- We can accommodate you by letting your first dog run early (and/or your last dog run later) or giving you a 5-minute rest between dogs. We may run other dogs during that 5-minute rest.

Bitches in season (BIS): May run at this trial. To be able to run a BIS, you must immediately tell the trial secretary who will mark BIS on the running orders. The BIS will remain in their running order and run in panties provided by the owner. The handler/owner acknowledges the inherent risk of running a dog on an agility course with BIS pants on and assumes all risks by doing so.

NFC (Not for compete): If you intend to run NFC and use either a toy or the NFC Food Reward Station (see below), you MUST declare it to the judge prior to your run. If you do not, you will be eliminated and must leave the ring immediately. Your toy may be thrown but cannot be audible.

Not For Compete (NFC) Food Reward Station: A designated station is set up ring side (please see the course maps for location), so during a NFC run you can reward your dog with food and then come back into the ring to run. **Please see section 4.12a, page 36 of the UKI Rule Book for complete details.
