Arrival & Setup

- **Do not arrive before 8:00 AM** unless you are helping with setup.
- We will not be taking day of show entries- the trial is full!
- Obstacle familiarization will be before the briefing. General briefing 8:50AM
- This allows the team to prepare the space quickly and start on time.

General Information

- This is a very full trial, and we will need to move efficiently throughout the day.
- Volunteers for **bar setting, timing, and scribing** are greatly appreciated.
 - No experience needed—we are happy to teach!
 - More volunteers, especially bar setters = a faster, smoother trial for everyone.

Crating & Ring Etiquette

- Dogs crated in the **training room**:
 - Must remain crated until they are **one of the next three dogs to run**.
 - **No squeaky or distracting toys** allowed.
- **No human food or drinks** in the training room.
 - Only dog water is permitted at the designated watering station by the door.
- Additional crating space is available in the hall.
 - Water may be provided in crates in the hall.
- If your dog is **noisy**, you must crate outside the ring area so the judge can be heard.

Seating, Crates & Cleanliness

- You may bring your own chair and crate.
 - Chairs with feet (not bars) **must have a mat underneath**.
 - All crates **must have mats underneath**.
 - Clean up if anything is accidentally spilled.
- Please **pick up after your dog**.
 - Trash cans are located outside each door.

Food

- It is recommended that you bring your own lunch, as the trial moves quickly.
- There are food options nearby and a convenience store ½ mile away.
- Light snacks are usually available in the lobby.

Run Order

- Tall to small
- Beginner 1 & 2; Intermediate 1&2; Superior 1&2
- Game 1 (Mute Agility)
- Beginner 3, Intermediate 3, Superior 3
- Game 2 (Scamper)
- Game 3 (Mikey's Game)

Awards & Ribbons

- Ribbons are self-serve.
- If you have questions about awards or scores, please see **Jerry or Joey**.
- Title tracking:
 - TDAA provides **title trackers** on their website.
 - Downloading and printing these is **highly recommended**.
- Please do not hesitate to ask questions—we want everyone to have accurate records.
