We are privileged to play SpeedWay at Pineland Farm Equestrian Center and we ask that you respect the grounds and the privacy of the horses. Please be mindful of the areas taped off to protect the privacy of the new young horses. No dogs are to be walked anywhere near the horses. Do not pet or photograph horses.

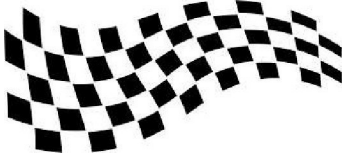
Please review the attached maps for traffic flow inside the building and on the grounds and acknowledge the restricted areas.

We truly appreciate our volunteers as we couldn't run the races without our Pit Crews! Anytime you volunteer in the ring, you will receive \$2 in CASH for each class worked. SO don't miss out, once you've worked a class don't forget to see our Volunteer Coordinator! We will also have some special raffle for those heavy lifters that help with set up and clean up- certificates for Free Runs, Gas card, and a back-up charger for your various devices.

GATE: We will have old-fashioned paper check in sheets. You may check your dog in when you arrive or before the walk through. The gate sheets will be available on a table near the entrance. A volunteer "gate" will call the dogs running order to help you line up. Please be aware that Speedway runs tend to be fast and prepare accordingly.

Entering the Arena/ Ring

We will be entering & exiting the ring from the equipment garage area and the front doors of the building to the parking areas. Please be aware of all signage & your dog when exiting the building.

We will be using our magnetic gates & a leash box at the ring exit to expedite leaving the ring & leashing your dog as you celebrate your run.

Leashes: If you choose to run with your leash, it must be secure and your dog cannot touch it during the run. Otherwise your leash will be transferred by our leash runner to the chair inside the exit leash box. Remember if you should touch your dog or the leash is grabbed by the dog during the run this will result in an NQ.

ACMe Café

There will be a couple warm crockpot items and the hotpot steaming to help keep you fueled for the races. And as always there will be water & snacks available for our volunteers throughout the day. You may also choose to go up the street to Pineland where there are sandwiches and other local treats!

Bathrooms

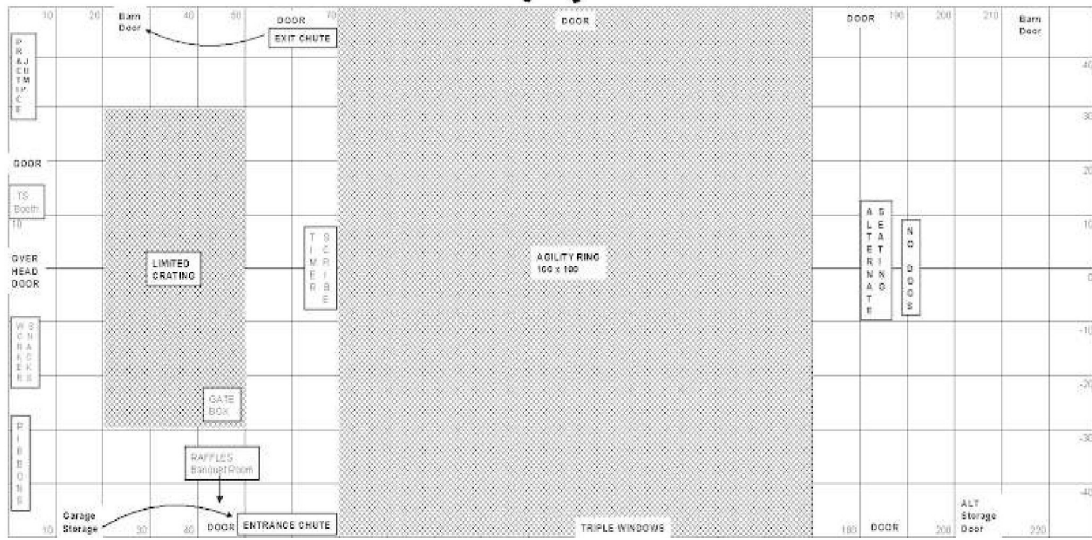
