Turn LEFT onto Paseo Real.

GO 1.8 miles, go RIGHT onto South Polo Drive – LOOK for sign for HIPICO.

FOLLOW THE RED LINE, BELOW.

Stay on the main road to the GRAND PRIX FIELD. Go PAST that, then turn left into the parking area:

FAST CAT TESTS

The purpose of the AKC Fast CAT event is to provide all dogs and their owners an enjoyable, healthy activity in which they can participate. Dogs run singularly. The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into MPH (miles per hour). Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. Titles are awarded when a dog has accumulated a given number of points.

Fast CAT Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC

Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners (CP) program. Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in-season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event (an event is defined by an event number).

Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. TTBC recommends that your dogs be in good physical condition before attempting the Fast CAT 100-yard dash. TTBC and HIPICO assume no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these Tests.

EARNING POINTS

A. The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is averaged into MPH.
MPH = (204.545)/dog's time.

B. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

C. Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

SUFFIX TITLES are earned by accumulating points. The following suffix titles will be awarded:

BCAT = 150 Points; DCAT =

500 points; FCAT = 1,000

points; and

FCAT followed by a number (e.g., FCAT 2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on the dog's pedigree, with a higher-level title superseding a lower-level title.

- Light blue ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs.
- Special Rosettes for finishing BCAT, DCAT, and FCATx titles

A penalty of \$25 will be assessed for each loose dog not competing in the course in progress, and for 5+ minute delay of event.

Concurrent Tests using BLOCK scheduling: There will be 15 dogs for each one-hour time block. Each of the 15 dogs will run their first event, after which, the same 15 dogs, if entered in the second event the same day, will run their second event. Then they are done for the day and can leave the test grounds. The next block of 15 dogs will be called to the staging area. Time blocks will be assigned and handlers will be informed of scheduled time block(s) via email after pre-entries are closed. You can *request* a time block – we will try to honor requests on a first-asked basis.

Hours: The Fast CAT track area will be available half an hour prior to Test hours. Test hours are 9:00 am until 4 pm or until all scheduled time blocks are completed. It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready with a releaser at the start line AND a catcher at the finish line when their dog is called to the line.

Collar Rules: Prong/pinch collars are not permitted anywhere on the event grounds. Dogs may run without a collar, or wear a snug flat collar only. NO dangling bits, no tags, no martingales, no slip, chain, nor e-collars, no head collars. Equipment will be checked before dogs enter the start area; handlers will be instructed to remove inappropriate equipment. Dogs *may* run in a basket-type muzzle, if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from falling across the dog's field of vision.

Check in, Roll Call and Inspection: Every dog must be inspected before each run. At inspection, bitches in-season, lame, and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Bitches known to be in-season are not to be brought to the event. Check-in and get inspected at least 15 minutes before your run time. If you do not check-in within one hour prior to the end of the test closing time, we will assume you are absent. No refunds for absent dogs.

AKC RULES: Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run, but must remain either at the start or finish area. Handlers are not allowed to entice dogs through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER or use the dog's name only.

Refunds: Handlers may pull out of an event **prior** to closing date/time for any reason for a refund of Entry Fees only. **After** closing only Bitches in season or dogs found to be lame/unfit at inspection will be given the same refund policy. There will be no refund after closing for any other reason.

Canine Partner Program (CP) is a program for mixed breed dogs. The Canine Partners enrollment fee is a one-time fee separate from the dog's first Fast CAT entry fee. Canine Partners web page:

General Information:

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- All AKC rules regarding [sportsmanship and civility](#) apply.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC, TTBC, dogs, or persons will be asked to leave the test site by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC; entry fees will not be refunded.
- Electronic timing equipment will be used with stopwatches as backup.
- The Fast CAT course will be fenced with poultry/snow fencing.
- Dogs must be on-leash or confined at all times, except when competing.
- No Open toe shoes or bare feet allowed anywhere on the course.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and your children.
- Any dog that attacks a person or dog will be ejected from the grounds without a refund.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization, club members, representatives, and volunteers.

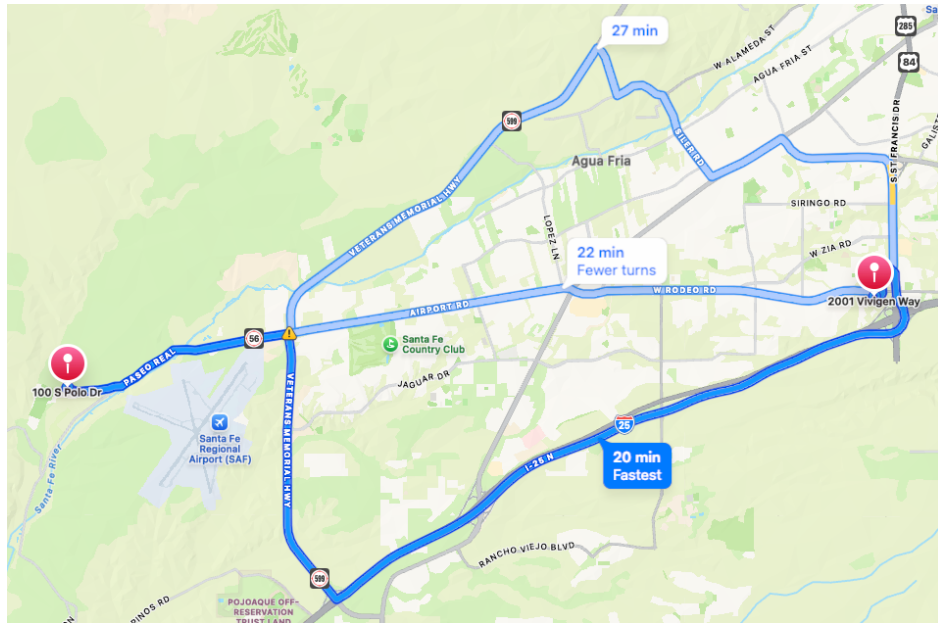

PREFERRED OPTION – ENTER and pay online via MyDogEntry

MyDogEntry handles events coast to coast and eliminates virtually all manual errors, including results submission to AKC. Create an account, add a dog, click on which events you want, add form of payment, and - done! (note: There is a \$1 Website Fee plus 3.52% Processing Fee)

OPTION 2 – Complete on-line entry online via MyDogEntry (\$1 website fee) then print and snail-mail with payment (no processing fee)
